SECTION B- HOUSEHOLD ARTS REGULATIONS

Entries close Tuesday, August 4, 2009 at 4:00

1. Superintendents and assistants will be at the Rock Barn at the Eastside Park Tuesday, August 4, 2009 through the duration of the fair. Rock Barn will be open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
2. Entries must be made between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Tuesday, August 4, 2009.
3. All articles of clothing must be entered on hangers and in plastic bags. Quilts and other larger handwork pieces should have plastic covering.
4. Soiled articles will not be accepted.
5. Only finished articles may be entered.
6. Every article will be under the control of the Superintendents and every possible care will be taken to prevent damage, but in no case will the Fair Association or the personnel in charge of this department be responsible for injury or loss that might occur.
7. An exhibitor will be permitted one entry in each class.
8. All articles must be the work of the exhibitor and not entered in NCM Fair prior to this year.
9. When there is no competition in a class, articles will be awarded first, second or third, or no premium, according to merit.
10. In order that this section may be educational and of benefit to fair visitors articles should be of type, style & material now in vogue.
11. This department will not act as a selling agency. No articles can be shown in this department with a "FOR SALE" tag attached.
12. Articles entered for exhibition shall not be removed except upon presentation of the property check and no article may be removed until Saturday, August 8nd from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and will not be responsible for articles remaining after 5:00 p.m., after which time all remaining articles will be in Fair office.

NO PREMIUM WILL BE PAID ON ARTICLES REMOVED BEFORE THE STATED TIME.

PREMIUM MONEY NOT PICKED UP WILL BE FORFEITED.
