GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. This show is open to all gardeners, no fees for entering.
2. This show will be judged by flower experts.
3. The Standard System of awards will be used: First-blue, Second-red, Third-white.
4. Entries may be made from 8:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Thursday, July 31, 2008 for specimen, arrangements & for container grown plants.
5. No entry may be removed before 4:00 p.m. and all must be removed by 5:00 p.m. Saturday, August 2, 2008.
6. Exhibitors are allowed one entry in each class, but may enter as many classes as they wish.
7. The show committee reserves the right to consolidate or subdivide floriculture classes and/or make any changes for the improvement of the show.
8. Exhibitors in arrangements shall place their own entries.
9. Materials on the State Conservation list will be allowed, provided, entries are labeled with botanical & common names & must be grown by the exhibitor.
10. Care is taken at all times to protect entries, but the show committee will not be responsible for loss or accidents.
11. Best of show award and most unusual flower or plant awards will be selected for additional recognition.
